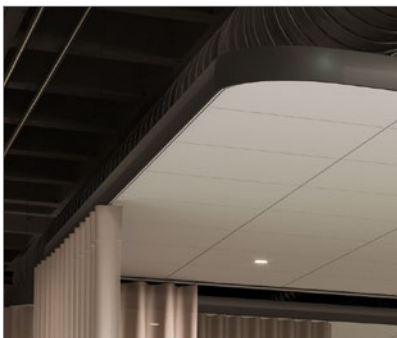

Description

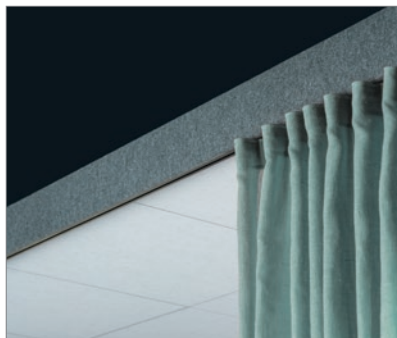
Rockfon Hub is an innovative and acoustic island platform for creating zones and space-in-space designs. Rockfon Hub is available in 4 standard dimensions and consists of a two-grooved black anodized frame – possible to be customized with felt - and concealed X-edge tiles in multiple colours. Curtains can be added as well. The platform is suspended to the soffit using subtle looking wire sets.

Restrictions

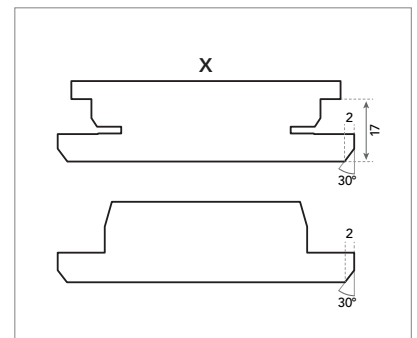
Due to the risk of corrosion, Rockfon Hub should not be used in swimming pools or outdoor environments. Furthermore, Rockfon Hub should not be used in areas subjected to wind load and drafts.

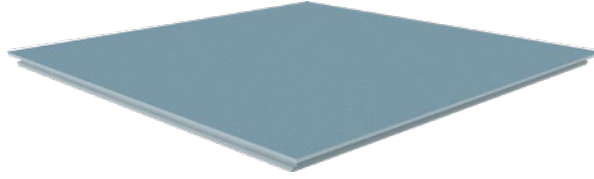

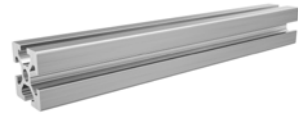

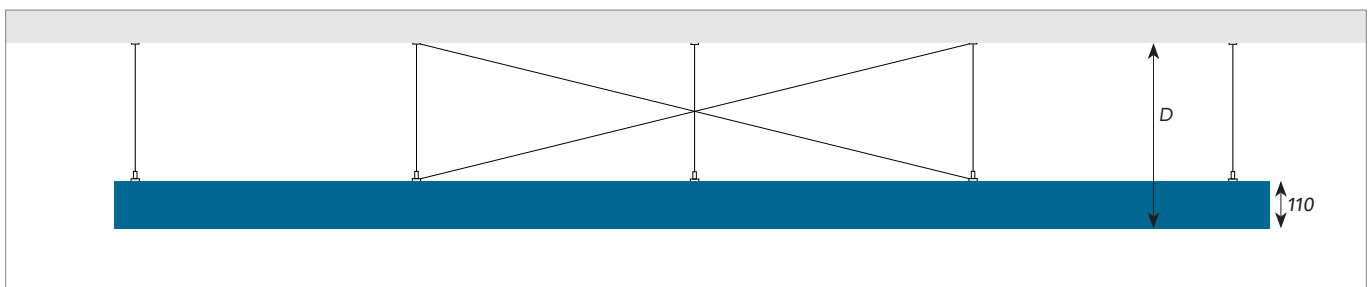

Installation

Ensure that the correct mounting fixings for the ceiling substrate are available. A break load of 200kg/suspension point is strongly recommended.

The installation of Rockfon Hub can be done at waist level (see step 2). If the platform is assembled on the floor (not recommended),

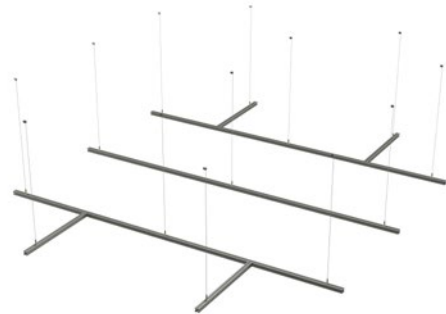
a work blanket should be used to prevent the Frame Profiles from being damaged.

For off-floor assembly (recommended), consider the ideal workheight for the installer. After assembly, Rockfon Hub can be lifted and leveled with a laser.

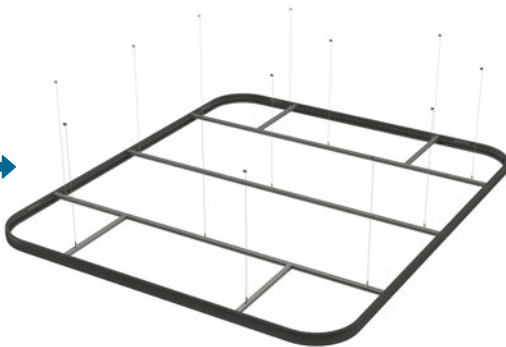

Use the Inter Connector R to connect the short Carrier Profiles to the main Carrier Profiles. Raising and lowering the suspension to roughly the same height can help make step 4 easier.



Make sure to use the mark on the carriers for proper alignment. First fasten 1, then 2.

Lift the Rockfon Hub using the 4 straight corner suspension cables (indicated with an arrow) that are connected to the main Carrier Profiles. First lift one side (2 suspension points), then lift the opposite side.

TIP



A gypsum panel hoist can be used to lift the island. Place it in the center of the Frame Profile and push up on one side and tighten outer corner suspensions on that side. Repeat on the opposite side.

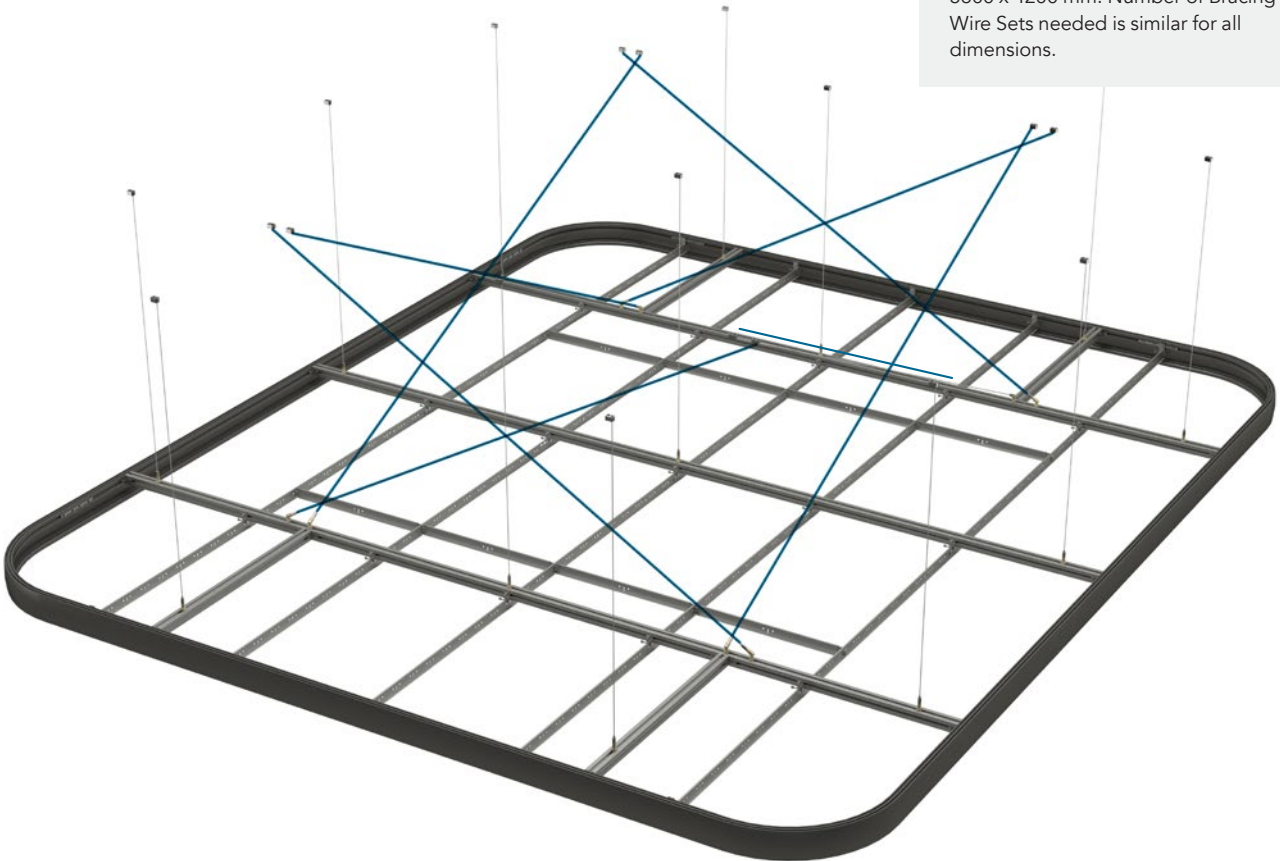

FINAL INSTALLATION STEPS FOR ALL SIZES**1** Cut the tiles using the Cutting Template.

Place four tiles next to each other as shown in the drawing. They should all have the same directionality and have the front side facing up. Then draw all the cutting lines on the tiles. Now all necessary corner tiles are cut.

Use fresh white gloves to handle the tiles in order to avoid fingermarks.

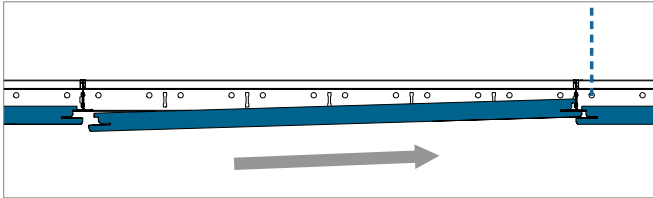

When laying out the tiles, make sure they all have the same directionality. The markings on the back should be used as an indication of direction.

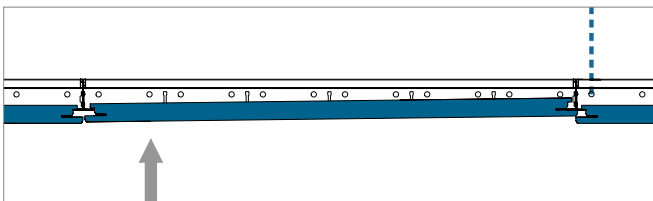

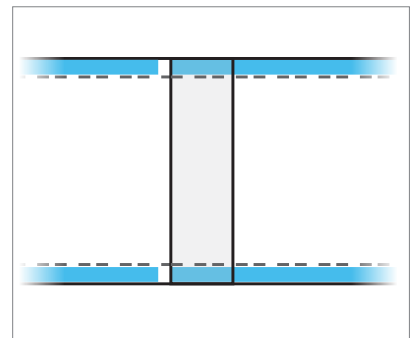
Before inserting the felt-ends in the frame, cut the felt with a 40 mm overlap. Leave extra wire on one end of the felt and cut it flush with the felt on the other.



Pull the wires out (a) and cut (b) them so they jump back inside the felt.



Pull the straight-cut felt over the felt with the retracted wires and push the wires in the slots.



The seam should look as follows. Now stroke out the last creases in the felt.

Service integration

Rockfon ceiling tiles are easy to cut and therefore, it is very easy to integrate service installations in our ceiling tiles. The cut-outs can be made with a simple utility knife.

When the system is installed to bear load, Rockfon recommends using a yoke or extra support arms that spread the weight of the service installation. Please be aware that, when installing a yoke or

support arms, the panel of Rockfon Hub is supported by the grid on only two sides. The size of the yoke should not be bigger than module 600 x 600 mm and the use of extra hangers to overcome deflection in the ceiling system is strongly recommended. When using support arms to spread the weight of the installation, Rockfon recommends spanning maximum 600 mm and the usage of extra hangers to overcome deflection in the ceiling system.

Planning

Rockfon recommends discussing the jobsite planning thoroughly and well in advance with other installers that have to work in or near Rockfon Hub. By doing so damaged tiles and dirty spots on the finished surface can be avoided, which reduces costs on the jobsite.

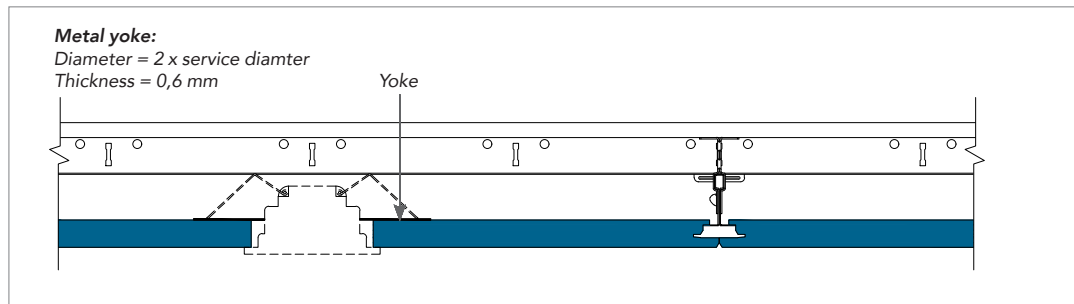

When installing services in Rockfon Hub, you should always follow local building regulations if more strict than the load bearing capacity constraints Rockfon recommends in the above table.

Special solutions with integrated services are, if available, shown in the section 'Specific Solutions'.

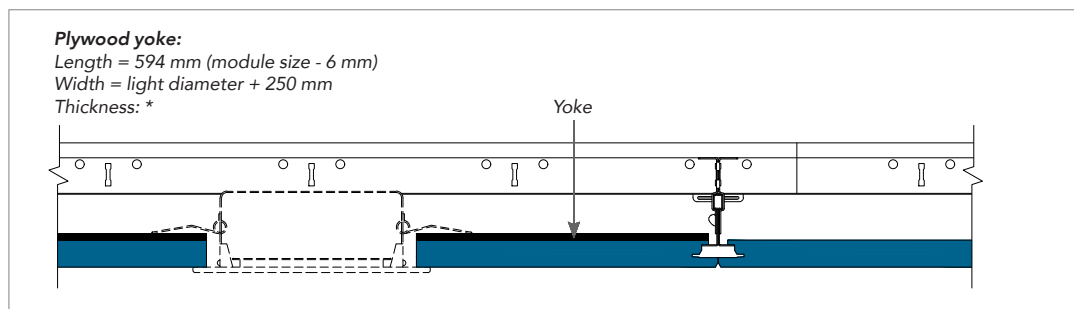
The integration of a spotlight, smoke detector, speaker, etc. (weighing < 0.25 kg/pcs).

The integration of a down-, spotlight, smoke detector, loud speaker, etc. (weighing $0.25 \geq 3.0$ kg/pcs).

Usage of a plywood yoke to spread the load on the back of the tile (as shown in the detail) or usage of support arms to spread the load to the grid system is strongly recommended. The use of extra hangers to avoid deflection is strongly recommended.



* The thickness of the plywood or metal yoke needs to be adapted in function of the weight, size and position of your service integration (e.g. downlight or speaker). The Plywood or metal yoke itself may not deflect after installing your service integration.

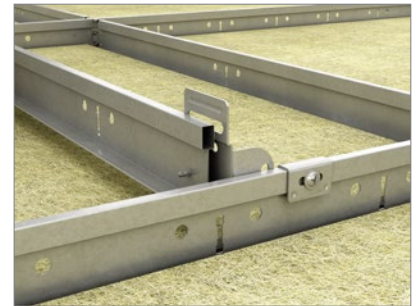
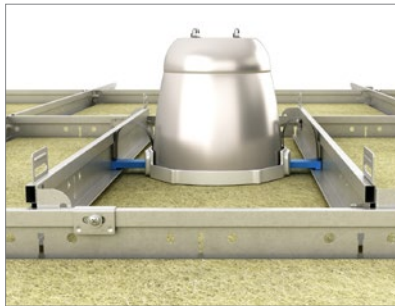
Specific Solutions

Bridging (Eliminate deflection)

Perfectly optimized for our Rockfon Systems, the bridging bracket feature gives the means to secure your T profiles across a variety of panel thicknesses ranging anywhere from 0 mm (only relevant for our Chicago Metallic T24 Click 2890 or Chicago Metallic T24 Click 2790) to 20 mm.

Easy to install, the bracket is a versatile, non-combustible tool and can be used for service integrations with different dimensions without the need of a using a yoke.

To install the bridging function of the bracket, simply screw fasten the Wall & bridging bracket for T profiles to your main runners and cross tees, transferring the weight of your service integration to the grid. This ensures that no load rests on the tile, eliminating concerns of deflection.



TIP



If bridging is required, order a Wall & Bridging bracket and Cross tee T24 Click 600 according to your needs.

General installation recommendations

Tiles

We recommend the use of clean nitrile or PU coated gloves when installing Rockfon tiles in order to avoid finger prints and pollution of the surface.

For an optimum work environment, we recommend installers always observe common work practices and follow the installation advice as shown on our packaging.

Cutting is made easy with a sharp knife. All offcuts and holes must be treated according to local Building Regulations.

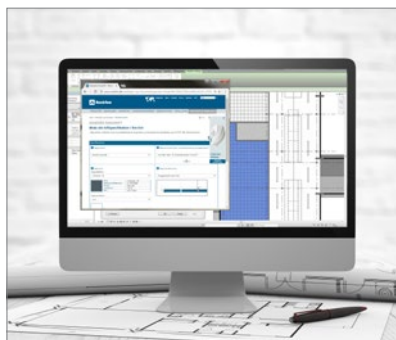
Note! Certain smooth matte surfaces are directional. To ensure consistency of the finished surface, it is important that all tiles are installed in one direction, as indicated by the arrow printed on the back of each panel
